Sermon Title: Access to God Through His Blood

Scripture Reading: HEBREWS 9:1-15

1. The shadowy nature of the tabernacle/temple:

vs Heb 10:1-2/Col 2:17/1 Cor 10:6-11

Typology = representation – symbol = meaning – shadow equals evidence of a reality to come.

2. Their insufficiency to clear the guilty conscience: vs Heb 9:9

The imperfection of the whole law system is affirmed by the sustained guilt of the conscience. David said it in Ps 51:16-17;

Heb 10:5.

3. The Christology of the tabernacle explained: vs Heb 9:1-5 The tabernacle of testimony: vs record, will, decree, and evidence. Witness to these three things:

Holiness of God/Sinfulness of Man/Need for a Mediator

Numbers 17:7-8

4. Christ the reality enters permanently: vs Heb 9:11-12

How did he enter in? By Humanity.

Tabernacle (John 1:14/Heb 10:5-7)

This was the Father's will. He enters in through Horror. The horror of separation (Heb 5:7). A fear of abandonment.

5. Our redemption is a triune work that accomplishes these things for us: vs Heb 9:14

The atonement of the Son, through the agency of the Spirit, for the satisfaction of the Father, that they might bring us to God.

1 Pet 3:18; Isa 61:1; Isa 48:12; Eph 2:18

Union with the Father, through the Son, by the Spirit makes us—with Christ, God's temple! 1 Cor 6:19
