Exodus 1:1-22 (KJV)

¹ Now these are the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt; every man and his household came with Jacob.

² Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, ³ Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin, ⁴ Dan, and Naphtali, Gad, and Asher. ⁵ And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt already. ⁶ And Joseph died, and all his brethren, and all that generation. ⁷ And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.

⁸ Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. ⁹ And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we: ¹⁰ Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out any war, they join also unto our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land.

And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses. ¹² But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were grieved because of the children of Israel. ¹³ And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour: ¹⁴ And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage, in morter, and in brick, and in all manner of service in the field: all their service, wherein they made them serve, was with rigour.

¹⁵ And the king of Egypt spake to the Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah: ¹⁶ And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; if it be a son, then ye shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live. ¹⁷ But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive. ¹⁸ And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have saved the men children alive? ¹⁹ And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women are not as the Egyptian women; for they are lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them.

²⁰ Therefore God dealt well with the midwives: and the people multiplied, and waxed very mighty. ²¹ And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses. ²² And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.

WHY IS FORGIVENESS NECESSARY?

"Forgive and you shall be forgiven"

Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven. Luke 6:37

Forgiveness is not a weakness it's a strength. The person that has it and exercises it bountifully knows a number of things essential to their happiness and Gods' glory

RETAINS: It retains relationships. To the one who is quick to forgive relationships are exceedingly valuable. They not are disposable to them. The loss of a friend a spouse an acquaintance to the bitterness of unforgiveness is not worth it.

REMOVES: It removes the real or perceived offence. As we are obligated to engage people we value to work through conflicts, we are certain that the only way to reconcile effectively is the actual grace of forgiveness, by the cross of Christ. Calvary is not to be mocked, it is the only place where sin is put away in earnest. **2** Sam 12:13

RESTORES: Moreover because the blood of Christ is effectual in the transformation of the mind it allows all parties to grow away from the offence, towards God, and towards one another. This is the fruit of real reconciliation. Jacob and Esau!

REFLECTION: The soul that is ready to forgive from a bountiful heart of humility taking earnest heed to the Masters words is aware that often the perceived ought or offences they hold may very well lie in them and not the other person. This is where the master says do not be quick to judge. Reflect upon the issue, determine it's worth, be sure of the long term consequences, proceed with caution, aim at forgiveness.

RENDERS: This ethic on the part of Christ to the people of God is designed to demonstrate the necessity and power of the gospel and the character of the Triune God in it.

The Father is merciful, the Son is the personification of it, and the Spirit applies it because they value the relationship. **Ex 34:6** " The LORD, The LORD GOD merciful.....PJesse

The Secret of Inward Peace

"But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us."

Eph. 2:14,15

Exodus 1:1-22

Proposition: The man is an endangered species. He has been since his creation.

- 1. Bearing fruit unto God is the mission of the Church: *Gen. 1:26,27 John 15:8/Col 1:6,10* the character of Christ in you by faith, and the conversion of sinners to Christ through Faith. The ministry of the gospel.
- The seed is in the fruit: vs. Gen 3:15 / Ex 1:1-7- Promise to Abraham
 Rev 5: 9,10 The fruit bears and perpetuates the seed. Gen 15:5-Potential/Power/Promise
- 3. Israel a type of a 3-fold process: Adam 1 / Last Adam / Church Adopted as a son along with Adam to point to and usher in the true Son. *Ex* 4:22/Mt 2:15
- A warfare from the beginning: vs. 8-10 / Gen 3:15—man a false god, the devil a demonic king, both servants of the God of glory – Prov 16:4/ Ps 105:24,25
- 5. Labor is anticipated: **vs. 11-14** Adam had to work, sin increased his burden, toil and curse, and sweat, pain, would permeate even the birth process. *Gen 3:16*
- 6. The role of the midwife: **vs. 15 -17**—A type of the ministers of the gospel. And every faithful local Church. a fourfold significance. 1 Thess 2:7-9 /Gal 4: 19
 - a. Assistants of the Spirit of life, vs.19
 - b. Save the men, *vs.* **18**—This is to preserve the identity of the family
 - *c.* Preservation of the true gospel: The truth that reveals the glory of God *1 Peter 1:25*
 - d. The revelation of Jesus Christ: Every man child born pointed to the revelation of Jesus Christ. *Ex 1:22/ Gen 3:15*
- 7. God shall see His seed: *Isa 53: 10-12*—By virtue of the incarnation of the Son of God, who is the seed. His assuming our nature, and thus being qualified to die, did die. He yielded his life a ransom for many, *Heb. 2:10*
