- c. He affects the covenant blessings:
Heb 13:20/Zech 3:1-10/Ezra 3:1-10
- d. A family Affair: 5:1/Heb 2:11-12/John 20:17

2. The Melchizedek order: 5:6-9/6:20

- a. His Pre-law/Post-law Priesthood: 2100 bc
- b. Law covenant 1500 bc
- c. A foreshadow of Christ Permanent Priesthood
Heb 7:15-17

3. Their disinterested, distracted, distorted dullness:

5:11/Acts 28:27/Mt 13:15

Lazy, stupid, sluggish, slothful, unable to hear the truth of the gospel:

- a. Legalism
- b. Works righteousness
- c. Self-righteousness – Rom 9:31-33

4. A perfect and eternal priesthood: Heb 7:1

“The Bread and Wine” Heb 5:7-9; 2:10; 10:14

- a. A celebration
- b. A victory won
- c. A recovery of the goods
- d. A complete Salvation
