**Sermon Title:** The Gospel To The Romans: True Judaism

**Scripture Reading:** Romans 2:13-29

- 1) **God's patience will save and damn: vs 4-5**
  - a) He restrains for a time by nature/not by permission: 2 Pet 3:9/Ex 33
  - b) His goodness despised by all: Acts 14:17/Luke 16:25
  - c) It has only one objective—that is repentance: Acts 17:27/Mt 3:2-3; 4:17/Acts 2:38; 17:31/1 Thess 1:10/Jonah 3
  
- 2) **The fig leaves of orthodoxy and right doctrine will not save you: vs 2:11-12**
  - a) Defending the Gentiles against the delusion of self-righteousness: vs 14-15
  - b) The law of conscience and the law of Moses has but one purpose: Repentance! Rom 3:19-20/Gal 3:16/Rom 10:2-3
  - c) God is no respecter of persons: vs 11/Acts 10:34-35
  
- 3) **Teaching does not save us: vs 17-22**
  - a) Teachers are the more condemned: James 3:1-2
  - b) Their life must correspond to their message: James 2:17
  - c) Faith in Christ must dominate both his doctrine and his deeds.
  
- 4) **Grace must teach us before we can teach others: Titus 2:11-15**
  - a) Living
  - b) Looking
  - c) Loving
  
- 5) **We shall all be judged according to our works: Rom 2:6, 13/Ps 62:12/Rev 19:15/2 Thess 1:8**
  - a) How do you respond to the law? Has it convinced you? 1 Cor 14:25
  - b) How do you respond to the gospel? Is it saving you? 1 Cor 1:18
  - c) They are friendly adversaries for the glory of God! Gal 3:24 (21)
  
- 6) **The Life of the Righteous and Rebel: vs 7-10**
  - a) The believer's life is one of patience, doing good, looking for glory (the reward of faith)
  - b) The life of the rebel is contention against the truth, commitment to unrighteousness
  - c) He will be damned by the fury of God's justice. (It's His reward): Rom 6:23

**7) The True Jew and Teacher is Christ: Zech 8:23**

a) His Righteousness is ours—The Skirt: Isa 61:10

b) His course of life is ours—The Walk: John 6:67/Rev 14:4/1 John 2:6

c) His destiny is ours—The glory of Christ: Rev 7:14-17/John 17:24
