

## Outline - Sunday, February 1, 2015

**Sermon Title:** The Gospel to the Romans: The Peace That Comes Through Justification **Scripture Reading: Romans 5:1-9** 

- 1. Justification leads to Peace with God: vs 1
  - a. The peace we have is not first for us: Rom 1:18; 2:5-6/Ps 7:11/John 3:36
  - b. God's wrath against the believer settled: Isa 53:10-11/2 Cor 5:17-21
  - c. Therefore, by faith, we have His peace: Isa 32:15-17
- 2. Christ is our access: vs 2/John 14:6; 10:1/Eph 2:18; 3:12
  - a. His atonement is our way in: Gal 2:20
  - b. He is our escort—introduced—"by Him": 1 Pet 3:18
  - c. His person is our vouchsafe: Rom 8:34/Heb 4:16; 10:22
- 3. The Joy of Glory to come:
  - a. The return of Christ: 2 Thess 1:10
  - b. The resurrection of the dead in Christ: 1 Cor 15:42-44
  - c. The glorification of our bodies: 1 Cor 15:51-52/Phil 3:20
- 4. Tribulation is the way: Mt 7:14/Acts 14:22/2 Tim 3:12
  - a. Right with God means wrong with the world: John 15:18-19/James 4:4
  - b. Right with God means wrong with yourself: Rom 7:23-25/Gal 5:17/James 4:4-5
  - c. This conflict is designed to produce in us a hope: 1 Pet 1:3-7
- 5. There is a supply of Grace, called the love of God, poured out.
  - a. Christ's love for us: John 17:24—desired
  - b. Christ's love in us: 2 Cor 3:6-7/Phil 1:19—contained
  - c. Christ's love to us: Acts 7:55-56—fulfilled
