THE GOSPEL TO THE ROMANS
“Who Shall Deliver Me From This Body of Death?”

Romans 7:18-25; 8:1-6

1. Six (6) reminders of what we've learned:

- a. Speaking to Jewish Christians: Rom 7:1; 2:17
- b. Persuading them of the superiority of Grace: Rom 5:17-21
- c. Their freedom in Christ is because of union with Him: Rom 6:6, 11
- d. Union with Christ comes with a grace package: Rom 6:14; 5:20/1 John 1:9/
Phil 2:12-13
- e. Allegiance to Christ is the consequence of a new nature: Rom 7:6/2 Cor 5:17/
Eph 4:19/Col 3:10/Gen 39:9
- f. There will be a conflict, a fight, a struggle until the redemption of our bodies:
Rom 7:25/Ex 17:6

2. Three (3) benefits to our inward conflicts – (Why Am I thus?)

- a. A right assessment of our selves: Rom 12:3/Phil 3:12/Gal 4:19 “I’m pregnant!”
- b. A hope that demands true dependence on God: Rom 8:24-25/2 Cor 4:7/Gal 5:7
- c. Grounds for sympathizing with lost sinners: Eph 2:8-9/1 Cor 4:7

3. The answer to the question:

It is a **WHO** that must deliver us Ultimately: Rom 7:24-25

- a. He **DID** having redeemed us: Rom 6:6/1 Pet 1:18/Rev 5:9
- b. He **DOES** having married us: Rom 7:6/Isa 54:5/Eph 5:25-27
- c. He **WILL** promising to come back for us: Rom 8:11/2 Cor 4:14/John 14:1-3
