Sermon Title: Preaching to Perfect Men

Scripture Reading: Duet 18:15/Col 1:21-28

- Preaching: The authoritative announcement of God's Word/The good news of the gospel/The forceful appeal of the truth leading to the obedience of faith.
 1 Cor 1:21/Rom 1:16-17/Titus 1:3/Rom 16:25/Acts 11: 14
- Perfection: entire, complete, possessing all of the qualities essential to your being:
 A baby Means mature, developed, full grown:
 Organic metaphor An adult

Principle/Process/Performance/Presentation - James 1:3

- 3. It is *the Purpose* of God: vs28/Gen 17:1/Deut 18:13/Mt 5:28
 - A Person: Heb 7:26/2:10/5:9/Christ
 - A Position: Col 1:28/2:10/In Christ
 - A Process: Luke 19:21/ Phil 3:7-12/James 3:2/Warning vs 18, 22/ Luke 8:14/Heb 6:33
 - Avoiding presumption embracing faith Heb 4:2
 - A goal and objective for which the believer who is called to maturity pursues:
 - An essential mindset of the believer for ministry: 2 Tim 3:16/Eph 4:11-16/Col 4:12
 - A means of witness and testimony for Gods glory: Luke 13:32 "Christ was made perfected –

Abraham's faith, made perfect – James 2:20-22/Paul 2 Cor 12:9

- 4. A *Profession* we do not make of ourselves: The *perfect* do not *call themselves* perfect. Job 9:20/Phil 3:12/1 John 1:9/God does! Noah, Job, Abraham, David, us!
- 5. A *Presentation* for the last day: *To be presented Perfect is (our) Hope of glory! vs 28b, c "That we may"* A future goal Rome 8:26 (Hope) Eph 5:25-26/Jud 24/1 John 3:4-5/Psalm 138:8 hope!
