Sermon Title: **DESPISING HIS GOODNESS**

Scripture Reading: Numbers 14:1–24/Hebrew 6:1–4

1. Out of the abundance of the heart doth the mouth speak: Mt 15:18/Prov 4:23-25

2. **Humility and Outrage:** 14:56; 32:31-34 - (Neh 9:17)

Democracy without God is rebellion – Joshua/Caleb- another spirit – Num 14:9/24

RECAP THE 7 LESSONS

- a. The taste is a proof of His faithfulness to us: vs 21-25/John 20:27
- b. They correspond to the grace of God presently operating in our life:
- c. **Properly evaluating this journey of faith:** vs 26 -29—Tell the truth faith is hard! Luke 14:27/John 16:33/Mt 10:16/Mk 9:35-38
- d. A knowledge of the warfare is essential to the truth, <u>but it doesn't produce faith:</u> Eph 6:11/1 Cor 2:11/1 Pet 5:8/1 Cor 14:20/Phil 4:8/ Phil 1:27/2 Thes 3:2
- e. Faith is a gift of God: Eph 2:5-8/1 Pet Elect 1:1-2/2 Cor 4:13—
 "The/Non elect" (Babe/ Mature) 2 Visions two different emphasis: Num 13:30
- f. **The intolerance of Faith:** 14:30—When is faith to be intolerant?

When it can clearly see the promise, when the glory of God is at stake and, when the enemy has blinded the people of God with fear!

- g. A crisis of identity occurs where faith is absent: And the way of faith becomes offensive. "We are grasshoppers in our own eyes:" "Blessed is He that is not offended in me" Mt 11:6 "Horizontal dilemma"
- 3. A type of our present day apostasy from the gospel:

Num 13:31 (They are stronger than us) – UNBELIEF – (3 areas)

- a. The cross
- b. Evangelism
- c. Judgment day

The power of God/glory of God/fear of men—Rom 1:16-17/Mt 10:32

4. **Christ will be exalted** *by His* **people:** Num 14:21— He is swearing to himself against the unbelief of the apostates. Mt 28:19-20; 24:15/John 12:32
