The Account of Our *Practice - Exploits*

Dan 11:32-35



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Vs 1a: Jesus Christ the subject for Theophilus (lover of God)

- a. All Believers Love God: Rom 5:5-6
 - It's commanded in the law- Mt 22:37
 - imparted in conversion Heb 8:10/1 John 5:1-2; 4:19
 - Every believer is a Theophilus
- b. Believers are taught personally of God: John 6:45/1 John 2:27/1 Thes 4:9/Eph 4:20-21
- c. Luke a type of the Spirit of God Theophilus a type of all believers John 12:21-23; 14:26; 15:26; 16:13/Luke 1:3-4

Vs 1b: The Scope of Luke account:

"All that Jesus began to do and teach"

From *His birth* to *His death* He *began* something, through his actions and teachings

Archo – start, initiate – vs 22/Lk 3:8/4:21

Vs 2a: Taken in order to continue His work: Vs 9

John 10:14-16/Luke 24:50-51/Mk 16:19

- a. His Father's work was finished
- b. His work continues to the end of time
- c. Accomplished by the Spirit through the _____?
 Mt 16:18-19

Vs 2b: An Apostolic Charge through the Spirit: Heb 3:1

- a. The symbolic act John 20:22 (LIFE to minister) Ezekiel 37:9
- b. The *right* of conference
 - (a finished work) John 20:21
 - (Sent) John 17:17-19
- c. The *character* of the commission
 - (the forgiveness of sins) Acts 10:42-43/Lk 24:45-49

Vs 3: He Showed HIMSELF alive

(confirmed witnesses of his bodily resurrection)

- a. forty days
- b. 10 times
- c. eating, drinking, and fellowship
- d. power

Mt 28:9-10/Luke 24:13/1 Cor 15:6-7/John 20:19, 26, 21:1/ Acts 1:4; 10:41



"Child of God, See How your Savior keeps you believing?"

Inter.
