Sermon Title: THE GOSPEL OF YOUR SALVATION — PART 1: You Were Dead

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:1-15

- 1. **Man in his natural state is** *spiritually* **dead. vs 3** (4:17-19)alienated, estranged, separated from *the Life* of God.
 - a. The walking dead Luke 9:60; 15:24
- 2. To be *spiritually* dead is to be controlled by our sinful nature:

vs 3a Life for the natural man is lived at the core of his lust.

Eccl 6:7/(his own desires) "He loves his sin" Job 15:16/

1 John 2:15/He does not live for Gods glory - 1 Cor 10:31

3. The natural man is at war with God in his mind: vs 3c

And as such is under the present wrath of God in his being. Col 1:21/John 3:36/Rom 8:5-8

Enmity defined: variance/alienation/hostility - angry with/at war

4. The will of natural man is bound to both his nature and Satan's authority: vs 2 John 8: 44-45 -

Unwilling—John 5:40/Unable—John 6:44/The ethic—2 Tim 2:24

- 5. God has to wake him up and walk him out: Acts 12: 6-11
 - a. In a death sleep
 - b. In spiritual prison
 - c. The Spirit must quicken you
- 6. Mans spiritual state is affirmed By Gods remedy for it:
 - 2 Cor 5:14-17/His death was 3 things:
 - a. an act of justice—Rom 6:23
 - b. a substitutionary sacrifice—the believer was dead
 - c. the grounds for deliverance from death—Rom 4:25
- 7. The Act of salvation is designed to render all glory to God:

Eph 2:5

The World is dead—We were dead—Christ died: and we live by faith in Him!
